LOWERY'S LINES

Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday, February 26. Our Ash Wednesday Liturgies are at 7am (Morning Prayer), 9am (Mass), 5pm (Evening Prayer), and 7pm (Mass). Traditionally Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting (for those under the age of 60), and abstinence from meat; but what other things could we fast and abstain from on that day?

Maybe we shut off and fast from our phones for a portion of the day? Maybe we abstain from social media (or making comments to posts on social media)? Maybe we abstain from speeding or texting while driving? Be creative with Lent. Each day of this season is an opportunity to grow closer to the Lord and push aside distractions that keep us from connecting with one another. Let us also remember to pray for and encourage our RCIA elect and candidates as they make their way to the Easter sacraments!

Additional Reconciliation Times during Lent

Beginning on Wednesday, March 4, I will be available each Wednesday of Lent from 5:30-6:30pm for individual Reconciliation (in addition to the normal Saturday 11:30-12pm time) in the Reconciliation chapel near the baptismal font. Our parish's communal penance service with individual confessions will be on Wednesday, April 1 at 7pm.

FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7

The account of the sin of Adam and Eve was composed as a classic example of how everyone sins. The author recognized that there was a standard pattern: We toy with temptation - we fall - then we make excuses.

Romans 5:12-19

Paul's letter to the Romans is his most detailed and important theological work. His purpose in this passage is not to teach about original sin, but to contrast Adam and Christ. From Adam we inherited a strong pull toward sin. From Christ (the "new Adam") we received a gift that is incomparably stronger: Divine Grace.

Matthew 4:1-11

Each of the Synoptic Gospels sets a temptation story at the beginning of Jesus' ministry. The version in Matthew is unique because the Evangelist supports it with references and quotations from the Old Testament, as Matthew so often does. Here there is a volley of quotations between Jesus and the devil.

Reflect: Can I name for myself, my predominant sin?
