MINISTERS OF PRAYER

- 1. Every minister of prayer is committed to spending one hour a month before the Blessed Sacrament praying for the good of the parish, our parishioners and specific prayer requests.
- 2. The schedule is set up on a 28-day rotation, so you are scheduled for **the** *same day every 28 days*. The weekly schedule will be published in the bulletin.
- 3. So that you know, the door to the Blessed Sacrament chapel is *open 24 hours a day*, *seven days a week* -- it's never locked. (The chapel has its own outside door at the very back of the building. Its glass & metal construction makes it look like the entrance doors in the front.) This means you can fulfill your commitment any time during your scheduled day.
- 4. If circumstances make it impossible for you to come on the scheduled day, come on a different day. Normally we have a calendar for people to sign in but due to our being in the Day Chapel we will not sign in at this time.
- 5. The basket with the prayer requests will be placed at the foot of the tabernacle. Take a few out when you come to fulfill your commitment. When you leave, take the requests with you and continue to remember them in your prayer until you return.
- 6. Your prayer can take any form that is comfortable to you: the rosary, Scriptural prayer, spontaneous prayer, prayers from a book, etc. You do not need to keep repeating the requests. They are simply your special intentions during the prayer time.
